

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

Maintenance and cleaning guidelines for the following floors:

- All solid and engineered floors of Original Chapel Parket
- All solid and engineered floors of AvanceFloors.

Warning

- The first 30 days after installation avoid any moisture or water on the floor.
- Remove dirt only with a vacuum cleaner or use other dry cleaning methods.

Cleaning

- Mop stubborn dirt away with Floorservice Parquet Cleaner.
- Mix approximately 100 ml Parquet Cleaner with 10 litres of clean water and clean the floor with a well squeezed mop
- Allow the floor to dry completely before walking on it.
- Floorservice Parquet Cleaner can be used for regular cleaning.

Maintenance

- Depending on the intensity of use, treatment with Floorservice Maintenance oil will keep the floor in optimum condition.
- Use natural maintenance oil for dark and natural oiled floors.
- Use white maintenance oil for natural-white and white oiled floors.
- Use antique white maintenance oil for smoked and white oiled floors.
- First clean the floor with Floorservice Parquet cleaner as described above and allow it to dry completely.
- Apply Floorservice maintenance oil in small areas in an even layer with a cloth with the grain of the wood
- For lager areas we recommend to use a buffing machine.
- Dribble the maintenance oil in the shape of a snake and polish it in with a buffing machine using a thick white pad.
- 1 litre maintenance oil is sufficient for approximately 80 to 100 m2.
- Depending on ambient temperature and ventilation the drying time is 6 to 12 hours.
- For detailed information refer to the technical product sheets and the information on the packaging.
- Floorservice Maintenance oil can be used for 1 to 4 times per year depending on the intensity of use.

Frequency

- Daily cleaning : Floorservice Dry Clean Set
- Regular cleaning : Floorservice Parquet Cleaner
- Maintenance normal use : Floorservice maintenance oil 1 to 2 times a year
- Maintenance intensive use : Floorservice maintenance oil 3 to 4 times a year
